School Trip to Bridlington

The whole school will be going on the trip to Bridlington on Tuesday 27th June. We hope that the weather will be kind to us, but please be mindful when choosing your child's outfit for the day that it is often cooler at the coast and to pack waterproofs if rain is forecast, also to cover up those heads and shoulders if the sun does decide to shine. Could you please pack a change of clothing (named) for paddling or to change in to if they get wet whilst paddling and also a small towel. Children may bring a small buckets and spade, but must be able to carry them themselves. Please remember a packed lunch for those children that opted to bring their own food.
