Credit Union

I've sent some information home today about the Hull and East Yorkshire Credit Union. They have asked if parents and children in the community would be interested in opening a back account. Teaching children to learn about the benefits of saving is a life skill and the school would like to support this service. Please read the information and fill in the School Saver application form and return it to school with your adult I.D., if you would like to open an account for your child...or for yourself! You will need 2 forms of identification. The identification is only needed for the adult who is opening the account on behalf of the child. The school will then store the information and pass it to the Credit Union so that they can process your application and open your account.

We are holding a launch event for the opening of the bank on Friday 9th March at 2:30pm. Please come along to find out more about how the bank will work and the incentives that you and your family may gain from opening an account. You may even choose to sign up on this day, so it's advisable that you bring your 2 forms of I.D. in readiness!

After the launch we will hold a drop-in session each Friday morning, starting on Friday 16th March, between 8:30am and 9:00am for pupils and parents/grandparents to deposit money into their account. This will run from the school hall and will be led by Rita Habron, a volunteer for the Credit Union.
