Dear Parents,

The children are currently learning about seaside towns and as the academic year draws to a close, we would like to take the whole school to the seaside on Tuesday 27th June. We will spend a traditional day at the beach - building sand castles, playing games, watching the tide ebb and flow whilst enjoying fish and chips!

The cost of transport for the trip is £7. We would like the children to be able to take part in as many activities as possible and without your voluntary contributions towards the cost of the trip we will not be able to run some of the trips we do currently. Please pay on ParentPay, if you haven't used ParentPay yet or experience any issues please contact Mrs Walker.

We will leave school straight after registration (please make sure your child arrives at school on time as the coach will be leaving promptly) and return to school by 4:00pm. Staff have visited the site to check facilities and safety and have arranged for the children to play within a marked-out area. A discounted price for lunch at a local café has also been negotiated.

Your child will need –

- suitable outdoor clothing for the prevailing weather and remember it can be much cooler with a sea breeze - (T-shirts, shorts, sun hats OR jumpers, cagoules, wellies). Children do not have to come to school in school uniform, they can come ready for the beach.
- a complete change of clothes to paddle in or to change into if they get wet! (shorts, T-shirts or swimming costume)
- small towel
- beach toys, buckets and spades (only those they can carry themselves)
- a packed lunch **only** if they really don't want to have fish and chips or alternative hot meal
- a bottle of water
- sun cream (to reapply themselves or we would prefer if they put on the type that lasts all day)
- any medication e.g. inhalers, travel sickness tablets (a medication form must be completed for any medication and given to your child's class teacher)

Children may bring cameras, at their own risk, but NOT electronic toys. They can also bring a small note pad and pencil to play with on the coach.

If your child would like a lunch from the local café, please send in the amount per meal or they may bring their own packed lunch.

We are looking forward to a wonderful day on the beach and we would be grateful for volunteers to accompany us. It would be helpful for the lunch slips to be returned to school by Friday 9th June so that we can confirm final numbers with the coach company and the fish and chip shop.
