Display Policy

Barlow Primary School is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment.

Introduction:

At Barlow Primary School we are committed to creating a stimulating, attractive, interactive, learning environment, which promotes and values all children's work and learning, in all curriculum areas.

Aims:

Displays in school will:

- celebrate all children and their achievements
- promote pride in the presentation of work
- represent different curriculum areas
- be educational, attractive, neat and stimulating
- show the use of a variety of learning and skills

Objectives:

- 1) Every child will have some of his/her work displayed during the school year.
- 2) All work displayed will be of the child's best/good quality.
- 3) There will be opportunities for older pupils to create their own displays.
- 4) Each classroom will have a variety of displays (interactive, 3-D, informative etc) covering different curriculum areas.
- 5) There will be at least one literacy display and one maths display in each classroom during the school year.

- 6) There will always be an RE display and altar area/display in each classroom and the hall - the RE display will reflect the current RE topic/season.
- 7) Class displays will generally not remain in place for more than one term unless they are ongoing information displays.
- 8) A variety of print will be used when displaying work.
- 9) Photographs, maps and posters can be used an integral part of a display.
- 10) All displays will be finished except where it is used as an ongoing teaching tool (eg. working walls.)
- 11) A photographic record will be kept of displays where appropriate and photos can be added on the school website.
- 12) All displays of children's work will have an explanation/blurb with them.
- 13) All displays will be properly secured and repaired when they become damaged or loose.
- 14) Display boards will generally not be blank, with old displays not being taken down until new displays are ready to go up.
- 15) There will always be some children's work displayed in classrooms (ie. not all displays will be informative).
- 16) All displayed work by children should be named.

This policy was written in January 2017 and will be reviewed in 3 years or before if the Head wishes.
